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### **Profile:**

Dr. Sanjib Kumar Basu did B.Com. (Hons) from St. Xavier's College, Kolkata and completed his post-graduation in commerce (M. Com) with 'Accounting and Finance' specialization from Calcutta University. He was awarded Ph.D. in Commerce by the same university in 2001.

Dr. Basu is a qualified Chartered Accountant and a Fellow Member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India since 1992.

Dr. Basu has been in academics for over twenty five years, teaching both at the undergraduate and post-graduate levels. Prior to joining St. Xavier's College, Kolkata, he worked as Assistant Professor in Accounting and Finance at the Institute of Modern Management and Assistant Professor in Accounting and Finance at Umesh Chandra College, Kolkata.

He has been guest faculty at the University of Calcutta, Department of Commerce (M.Com) for twelve years from 1991 to 2003 and has also been invited to deliver lectures as Guest Faculty in the Department of Management at the Royal University of Bhutan. Dr. Basu is also a Guest Faculty in Accounting and Finance in Certificate Courses and Training Programmes organized by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

Dr. Basu is the author of twelve text books for H. S (Class XI & XII), B.Com (Hons.) course and professional bodies' examinations including the books 'Accountancy' 'Auditing & Assurance' and 'Fundamentals of Auditing' published by Pearson Education.

Dr. Basu has presented a number of Research Papers at various National and International seminars. He has completed a minor research project on “Panchayat Accounting in West Bengal” funded by the University Grant Commission, Government of India. He has also completed a major research project on “ICT Intervention in Gram Panchayat Accounting in India” also funded by the University Grant Commission, Govt. of India.
