Continuing with the journey which began in 1995, the Department of Computer Science which had taught a few ten students then has grown and caters to the needs of about 500 students now. In keeping with the tradition and motto of the College, the department students and teachers have continued to excel in the field of Computer Science and application.

The year 2014 proved to be a very fruitful year for the department in terms of academic excellence and development. The re-structured curriculum, which was introduced during the session 2013-2014 received very positive feedback from students and academic experts alike. The implementation of the updated new syllabus, meant that upgraded laboratories, both at the under graduate and post graduate levels would have to be introduced and developed. This challenge was effectively met by our active and untiring teaching and support staff members of the department. As Computer Science and technology are evolving and changing

rapidly, the teachers have to continuously upgrade themselves along with their regular assignments and duties.

At the PG level, under the restructured curriculum, Term-Paper is introduced in the 3rd semester. This has given an exceptional opportunity to the students to involve themselves in research work and will help them to take up higher studies in reputed institutes abroad and in the country. The department plans to release a yearly research journal with the outcome of the students' term-papers under the mentorship of the teachers.

The students have taken a keen interest in the research field, with more than 30 papers being published in International Journals and conference proceedings under the able guidance of our teachers. The students of both undergraduate and postgraduate courses for the last session are well placed. They have been placed in reputed IT companies like Orient Entertainment, Cognizant, PWC, Wipro IT, Odessa technologies, IBM Daksh, Ogilvy, Innofied Solutions Pvt. Ltd., etc. Most of the other students opted for higher studies and have enrolled themselves in reputed Universities/Institutes in our country

The teachers in the department are actively involved in research and have published research papers in many renowned Journals like Springer, Elsevier, IEEE, IJCA and IJACR, to mention a few. The number of publications by them are more than 50.
