IQAC has conducted a feedback from all stakeholders as part of annual quality assurance activities. An analysis report is also created for every question.

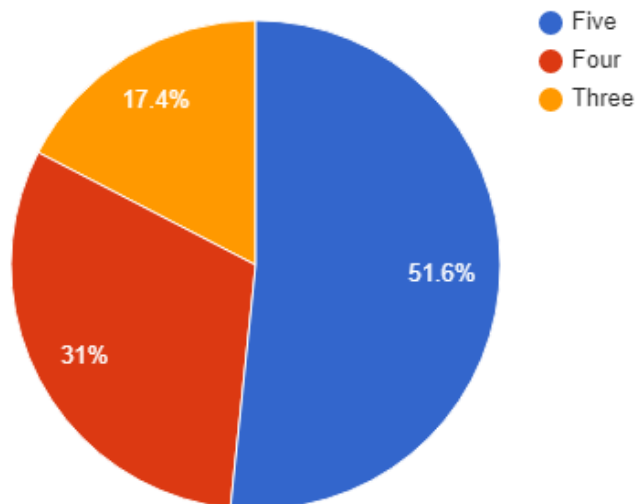
Recommendations are prepared based on the analysis report and forwarded to the management for further action.

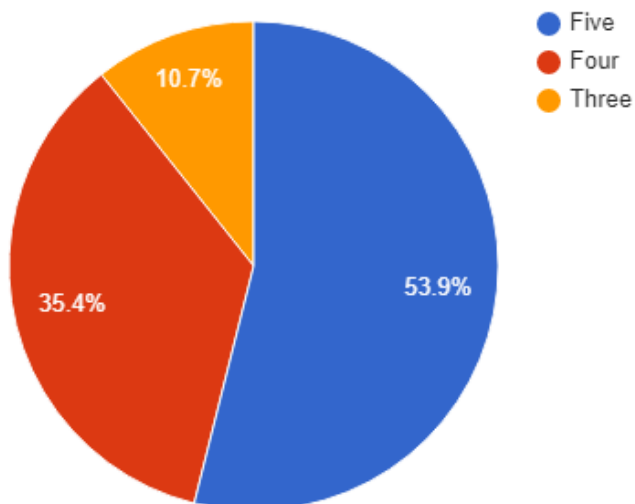

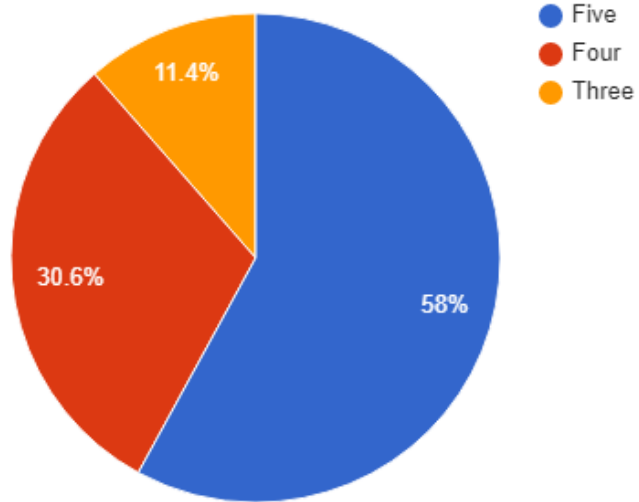

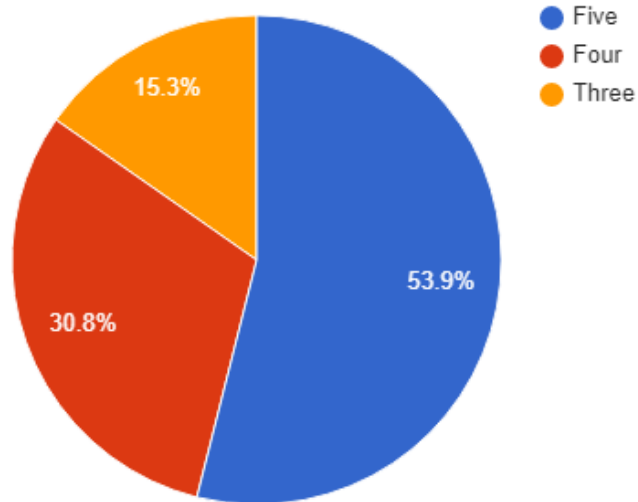

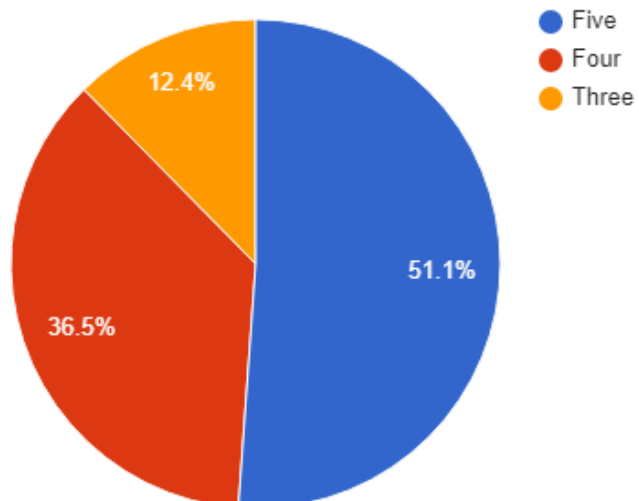

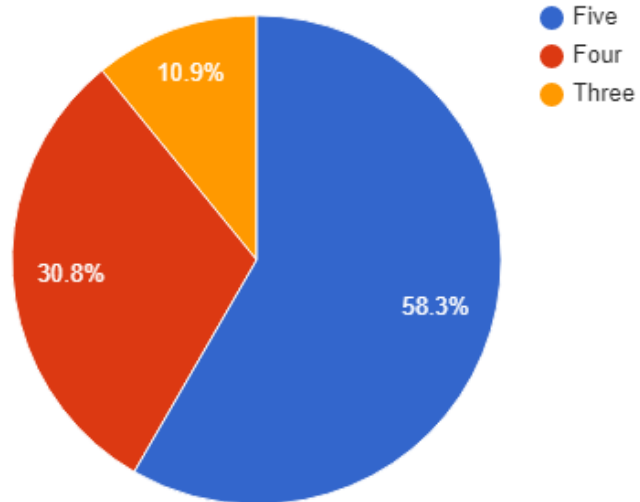

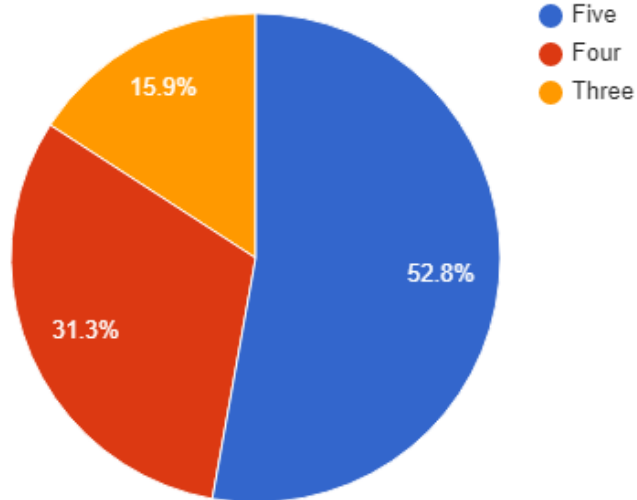

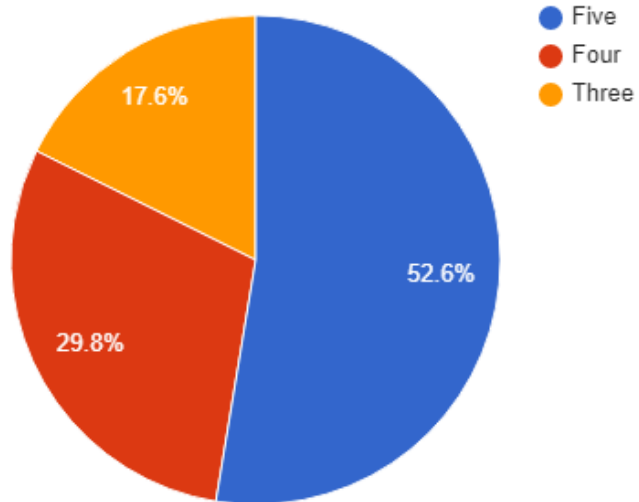

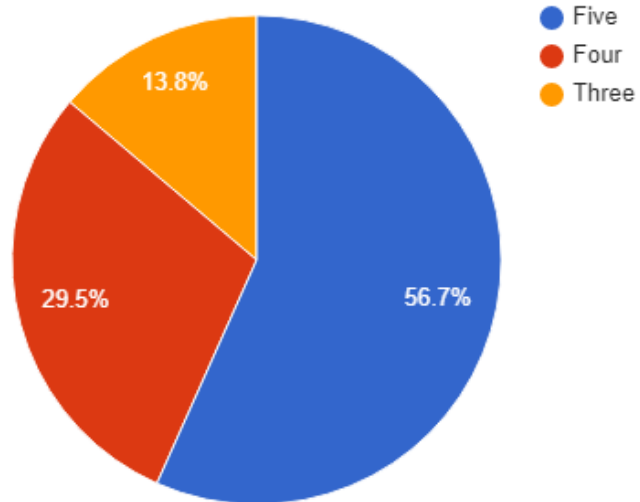

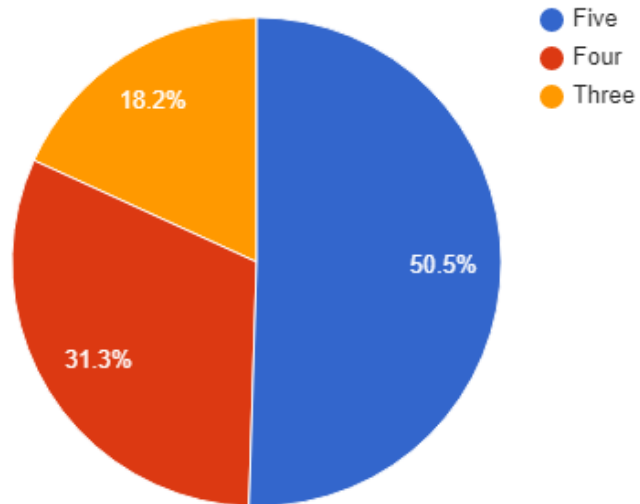

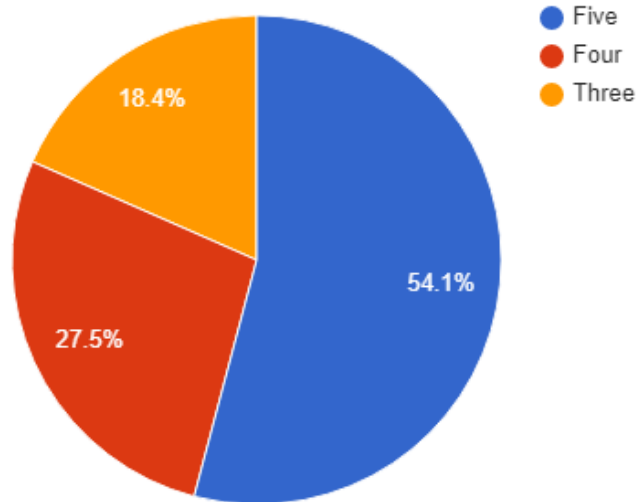

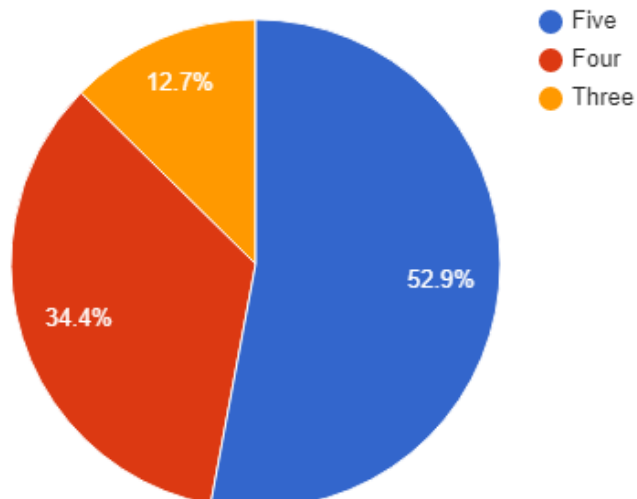

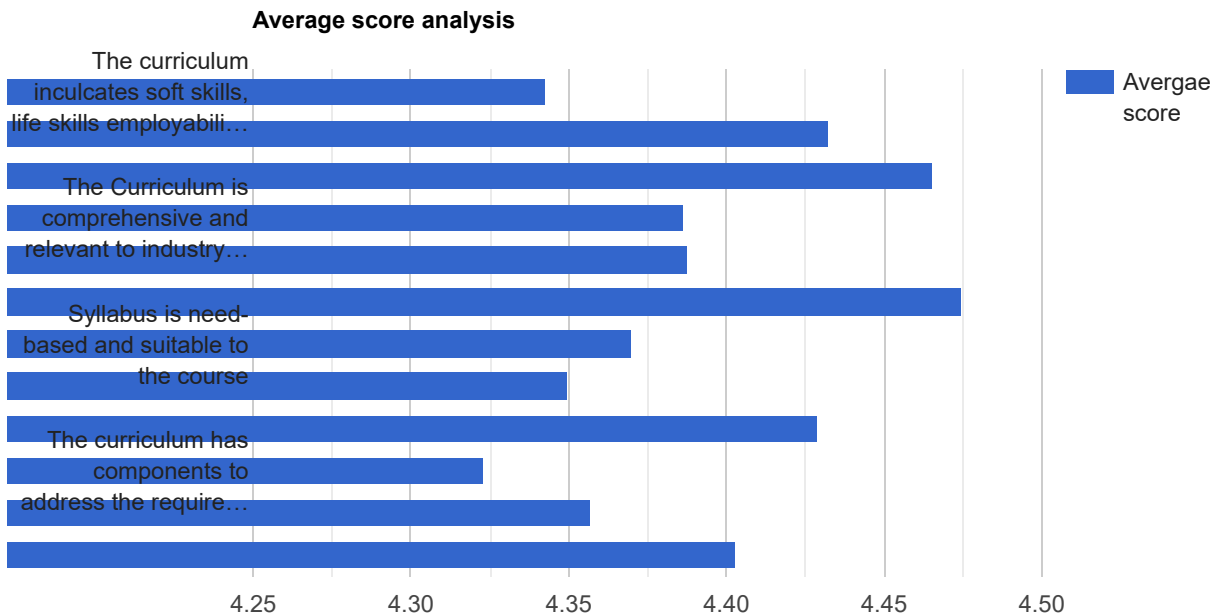
