
IQAC has conducted a feedback from all stakeholders as part of annual quality assurance activities. An analysis report is also created for every question.

The questionwise response analysis is presented below.


Question: The curriculum has good balance between theory and applications


Question: How do you rate the competencies/outcomes in relation to the course content?


Question: How do you rate the sufficiency of the courses related to industry that are included in the program?


Question: The curriculum incorporates soft skills needed for employment.


Question: The syllabus has content for developing skills to handle problems at work place.


