Curriculum feedback for faculties


IQAC has conducted a feedback from all stakeholders as part of annual quality assurance activities. An analysis report is also created for every question.

The questionwise response analysis is presented below.


Question: The curriculum inculcates soft skills, life skills employability skills and encourage to participate in extra-curricular activities


Question: The curriculum is well organised and easy to follow


Question: The curriculum brings in balance between theory and practicals


Question: The Curriculum is comprehensive and relevant to industry standards


Question: The curriculum equips the students to pursue higher studies and engage in research



Question: The class activities conducted have relevance to the objectives of the course and overall teaching learning quality




Question: Syllabus is need-based and suitable to the course


Question: The curriculum provides experiential learning through student seminars, group discussions, projects, field visits


Question: The curriculum gives exposure to the latest developments in the field



Question: The curriculum has components to address the requirements of the job



Question: The curriculum facilitates adequate self learning




