
IQAC has conducted a feedback from all stakeholders as part of annual quality assurance activities. An analysis report is also created for every question.

The questionwise response analysis is presented below.


## Question: The curriculum inculcates soft skills, life skills employability skills and encourage to participate in extra-curricular activities


### Question: The curriculum is well organised and easy to follow




















