

Special Lecture on 'Vivekananda: A New Vision'



Vivekananda is a seminal figure of the global nineteenth-century, but the pattern of his fame does not match his influence. Here he is a household name, but in the west few have heard of him. Why this is so goes to the heart of his life, his ideas, and his programme. I want to explain why he both challenged and enticed so many different audiences, from respectable New Englanders to Swadeshi activists. Rather than reinforcing the tired vision of Vivekananda as the first to unlock eastern spirituality for a materialist west, I want to focus on the paradoxes and uncertainties of his teachings. I will also investigate his relationship to nationalism, anti-colonialism, and Karma yoga. However, I will reinterpret his impact by integrating the "Indian Vivekananda" with the "global guru" by reconsidering his relationship to women, global intellectual history, and universalism in the fin-de-siècle world.





The Postgraduate and Research Department of Physics is known for its captivating and engrossing lectures and talks. In keeping with this tradition the 8th Fr. Verstraeten Memorial Lecture was conducted on 9th February, 2023, at the Fr. Depelchin Auditorium, from 3pm onwards. Professor Gayatri Banerjee, was our host for this event. The lecture was inaugurated and the inaugural address was delivered by Father Principal, Rev. Dr. Dominic Savio, SJ. It was followed by a speech from Dr. Indranath Chaudhuri, Head, Department of Physics. Dr. Shibaji Banerjee, introduced our esteemed speaker, Br. Guy Consolmagno, SJ, Director of the Vatican Observatory and the Pope's Astronomer, who joined us via a Zoom call. Br. Guy Consolmagno was felicitated, albeit virtually, by Father Principal and the Department of Physics. The topic for this lecture, "What's surfacing on Beenu?", was a gripping and compelling one. The NASA mission to asteroid Beenu, OSIRIS-Rex, brought back samples from its surfaces, which are being tested to understand and determine the composition and properties of the asteroid. Furthermore, he went on to explain the different types of asteroids, meteorites in space, and their properties and compositions. The detection of asteroids and the detailed study of their samples was a particularly engrossing topic. Br. Guy Consolmagno even spoke about the various missions to different asteroids and the threats these asteroids may pose to Earth. Our esteemed speaker broke down the complex topics into smaller, easier parts, which could be understood by one and all. The lecture was followed by an enthralling QnA session conducted by Dr. Suparna Roychowdhury. REPORT ON THE HALF-DAY STATE LEVEL SEMINAR ORGANIZED BY THE DEPT OF HISTORY

Seminar Title- Tides of Revolution; Revolts, Nationalism and Beyond in the colonial India

Idea of the Seminar-

Throughout the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, Indian history saw the emergence of various movements majority of which contributed vehemently to the development of the anti-British struggle. In this year, on occasion of the 75th year of Indian independence, we can look back to some of the important revolts and movements as well as their various facets. The proposed seminar thus, tried to throw light on two such significant events in the history of India, both in the pre nationalist and national movement phase e.g. the revolt of 1857, and the Swadeshi movement. The speakers discussed different features of these movements and through these, we were able to pay our homage to those persons whose sacrifice and contribution enabled Indian people to develop their consciousness and fight for their own rights.

Below I provide the details of the speakers and their topics for presentation-

- Dr. Manas Dutta, Assistant Prof., Department of History, Aliah University, Kolkata-The Great Revolt of 1857 and the Idea of Total War in India.
- Dr. Mimasha Pandit, Assistant Prof., Department of History, Mankar College, Bardhaman-Performing Swadeshi: Practicing Everyday Nationalism in Bengal, 1905-1912

The subjects of the presentations were interesting, informative and extremely crucial for creating awareness about our past history of revolution. The topics were directly related to the syllabus of SEMESTERS IV and VI particularly. The discussion, I am hopeful, was enormously fruitful for the students. 15 students from three semesters participated as volunteers. Students were given two hours credits for participation and one extra hour credit for volunteers.






