Action Taken Report on Feedback (2023–2024)

Curriculum and Department-wise Student Feedback

Feedback from students, alumni and other stakeholders for the academic session 2023–2024 indicated strong satisfaction with the academic framework but identified certain areas for improvement, particularly related to infrastructure, curriculum delivery and student support.

1. Curriculum Structure and Content

Feedback:

Students rated the quality of the course curriculum around 66–67% satisfaction, indicating that the curriculum was conceptually strong but could incorporate more applied components.

Action Taken:

- Departments increased the use of project-based assignments, student seminars and field-based activities within existing courses.
- Boards of Studies reviewed syllabi to include recent developments and emerging topics in relevant disciplines.
- Greater emphasis was placed on experiential learning components such as presentations, case discussions and research-based assignments.

2. Teaching–Learning Experience

Feedback:

The overall teaching-learning experience received about 66% satisfaction, suggesting scope for more interactive and engaging pedagogy. Action Taken:

- Faculty members adopted interactive teaching methods including group discussions, presentations and student-led seminars.
- Departments increased continuous assessment components such as quizzes, assignments and class presentations.

3. Infrastructure and Learning Environment

Feedback:

Infrastructure received comparatively lower satisfaction (around 56–57%), indicating student concerns about classroom facilities and learning spaces.

Action Taken:

- Maintenance and upgrading of classroom facilities and academic infrastructure were prioritized.
- Departments were encouraged to use ICT-enabled teaching tools and multimedia facilities available in the college.

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4. Library and Learning Resources

Feedback:

Library facilities were rated around 68% satisfaction, with suggestions for expanding reference materials.

Action Taken:

- Departments submitted recommendations for new titles and updated editions relevant to revised course content.
- Students were encouraged to utilize digital academic resources and databases available through the college library.

5. Administrative and Student Support Services

Feedback:

Students reported lower satisfaction with office and support services (approx. 49%), highlighting delays and procedural difficulties.

Action Taken:

- Administrative procedures were streamlined through greater use of online communication and improved coordination between departments and the college office.
- Efforts were made to ensure timely dissemination of academic and examination-related information.

6. Co-curricular and Academic Activities

Feedback:

Students gave positive feedback (around 69%) on co-curricular activities but recommended more discipline-specific academic events.

Action Taken:

- Departments organized seminars, workshops, guest lectures and academic competitions related to their disciplines.
- Students were encouraged to participate in inter-college academic events and research presentations.



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
