Action Taken Report on Feedback

Academic Year: 2024–2025

(Based on Students, Alumni, Employers, Faculty and Peer Feedback on Curriculum)

The IQAC analysed the feedback collected from various stakeholders during the academic session **2024–2025**. While most parameters received satisfactory ratings, certain indicators reflected **comparatively lower percentage scores**, indicating areas needing improvement. The following actions were taken.

1. Curriculum Relevance to Industry Requirements

Feedback:

Employer feedback indicated **65% satisfaction** regarding the alignment of curriculum with **industry requirements and job-oriented skills**.

Action Taken:

- Departments organised **industry-interaction sessions and professional lectures** involving alumni and corporate professionals.
- The Placement Cell conducted **career-readiness workshops on professional communication, resume writing and interview preparation**.

2. Experiential Learning and Practical Exposure

Feedback:

Student feedback showed **66% satisfaction** regarding **experiential learning components such as projects, seminars and field-based activities**.

Action Taken:

- Departments increased the use of **project work, student presentations and group discussions** in relevant courses.
- Selected programmes incorporated **field visits, case-study analysis and practical assignments** to strengthen applied learning.

3. Curriculum Exposure to Latest Developments in the Discipline

Feedback:

Alumni feedback recorded **67% satisfaction** regarding the **extent to which the curriculum exposes students to recent developments in the field**.

Action Taken:

- Reading lists were updated to include **recent publications and contemporary themes**.
- Departments organised **guest lectures and thematic seminars** on emerging areas in their respective disciplines.

4. Industry–Institute Collaboration and Skill Development

Feedback:

Peer feedback indicated **64% satisfaction** regarding industry–institute collaboration and exposure to domain-specific applications.

Action Taken:

- Departments initiated **collaborative lectures and workshops** with industry experts and professionals.
- Students were encouraged to participate in **internships, training programmes and applied workshops**.

5. Curriculum Support for Higher Studies and Research

Feedback:

Alumni responses indicated **66% satisfaction** regarding the curriculum's ability to **prepare students for higher studies and research activities**.

Action Taken:

- Departments strengthened **student research activities** through seminar presentations and **research-based assignments**.
- Orientation sessions on **postgraduate studies, research opportunities and academic writing** were organised.

6. Student Academic Engagement within Departments

Feedback:

Department-wise student feedback reflected **approximately 65–68% satisfaction** regarding **academic engagement through departmental activities**.

Action Taken:

- Departments expanded **discipline-specific seminars, workshops, academic society activities and inter-college participation**.
- Students were encouraged to present papers and participate in **subject-focused academic**
