



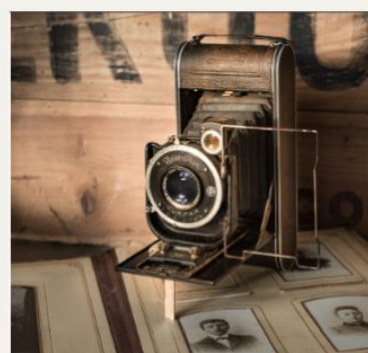

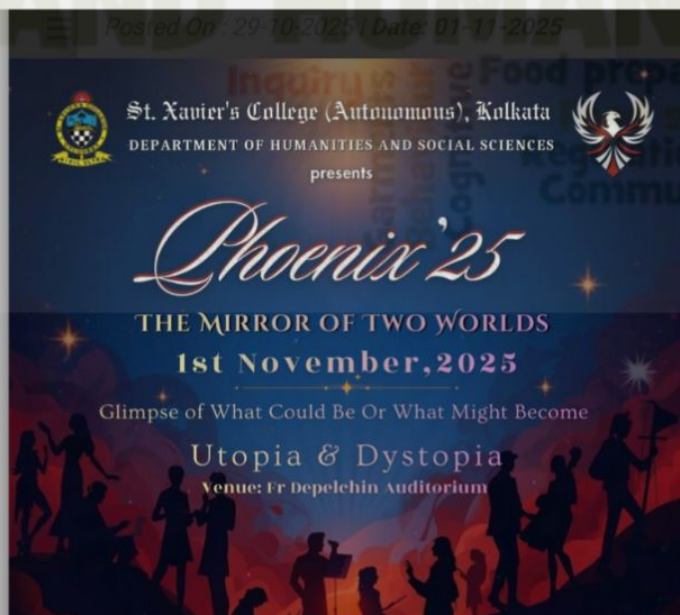

The event honored the life and work of the Jesuit priest and Comparative Literature professor.





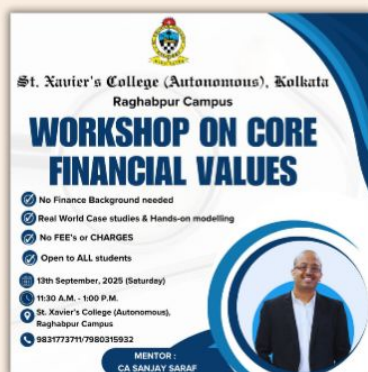


# POSTGRADUATE AND RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

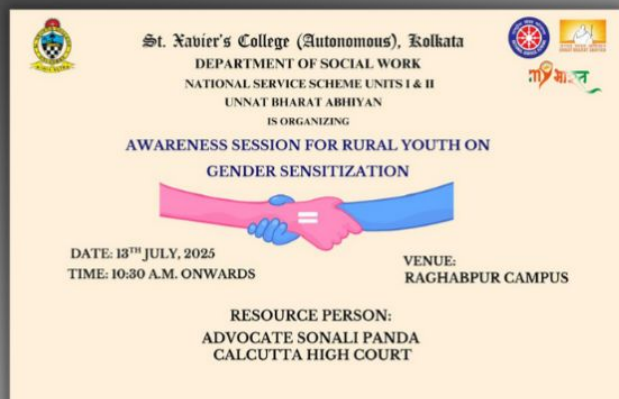






# NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME, UNIT II

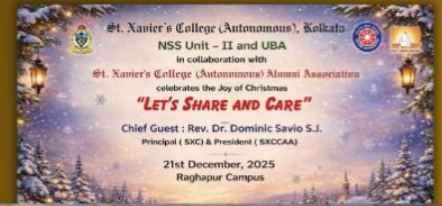

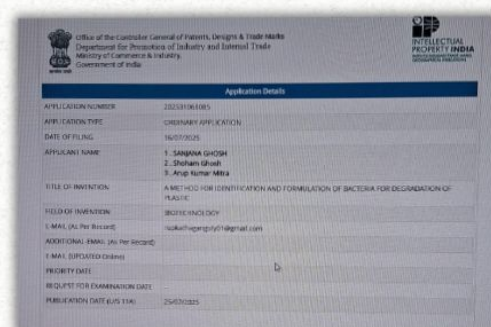
