- 6. Evaluate the role of education in promoting social inclusion, economic development, and cultural diversity within SAARC countries through a comparative lens.
- 7. Apply critical thinking and problem-solving skills to propose innovative approaches to addressing emerging issues in education within the SAARC region.
- 8. Demonstrate effective communication skills through written reports, presentations, and discussions on topics related to Comparative Education and emerging issues in SAARC countries.
