HUMAN RIGHTS : ISSUES AND PERSPECTIVES

Course Outcome:

1. Understand the key dimensions of human rights and the mechanisms in place to protect and promote human rights at the international and domestic levels.

2. Analyze the evolution of human rights and the role of international relations in shaping human rights discourse.

3. Evaluate the normative framework governing human rights and the constitutional and statutory mechanisms that ensure their enforcement.

4. Examine the relationship between human rights and democracy, and understand how the two concepts intersect and support each other.

5. Identify the various forms and consequences of human rights violations, and analyze the legal and ethical implications of such violations.

6. Explore emerging domains of human rights, including digital rights, environmental rights, and indigenous rights, and understand the challenges and opportunities they present for the protection of human rights globally.
