3. Applying: Students will be able to apply the principles of HRE in real-life scenarios, demonstrate the ability to advocate for human rights, and engage in critical thinking about human rights issues.
4. Analyzing: Students will be able to evaluate the effectiveness of different approaches to HRE, compare and contrast different perspectives on human rights, and assess the impact of HRE on individuals and societies.
5. Evaluating: Students will be able to critique existing human rights practices and policies, propose innovative solutions to address human rights violations, and assess the progress made in promoting human rights through education.
6. Creating: Students will be able to design and implement HRE programs, develop strategies to promote human rights awareness, and collaborate with others to advocate for human rights at local, national, and international levels.
