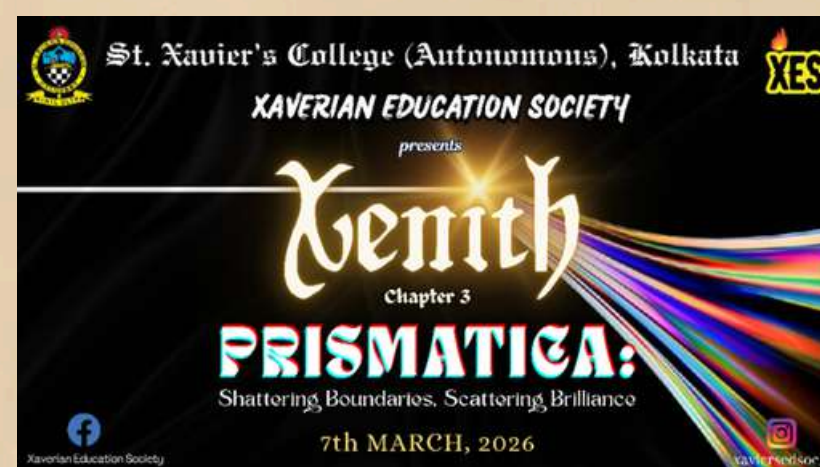

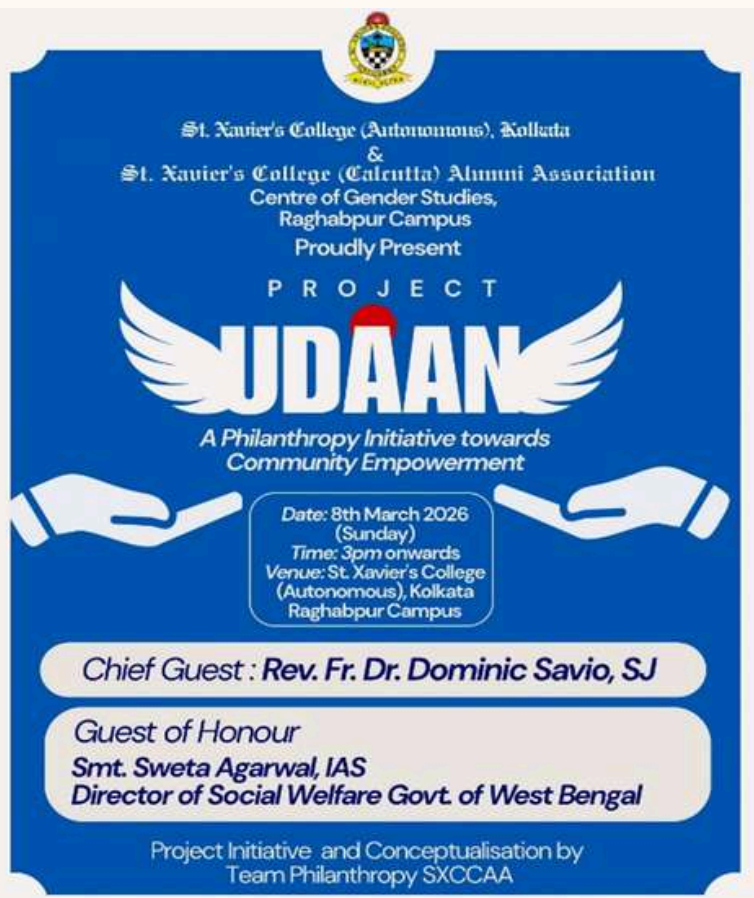

The initiative received an encouraging response, with over 250 women registering to participate


encouraging response, with over 250 women registering to participate. The programme will provide free hands-on training in producing mar-





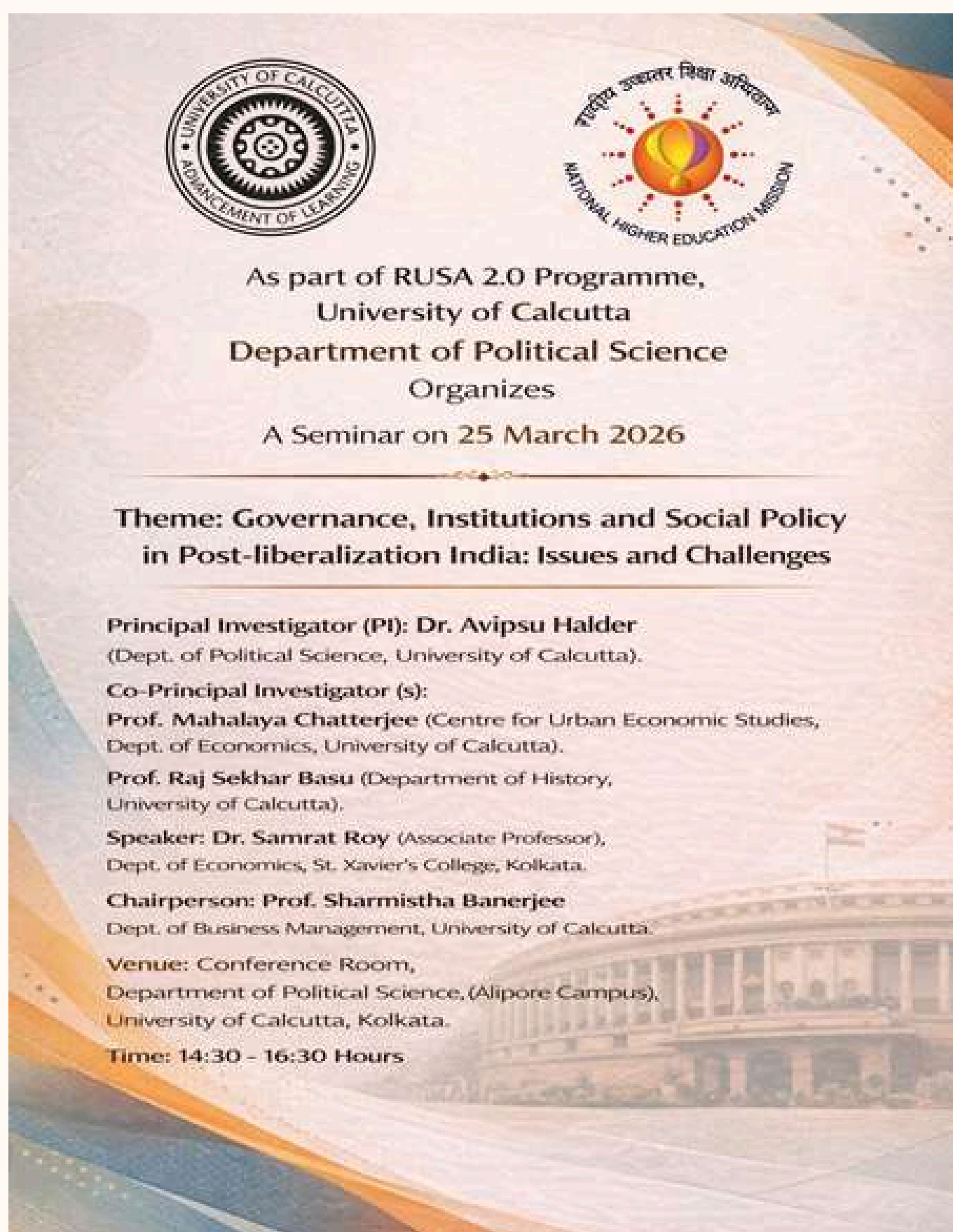

Abstract: Networks are ubiquitous across natural and engineered systems. New measures and methods in networks proposed by us will be discussed. We show how combining experimental and theoretical approaches can deliver new insights into diverse systems. Specifically, we will discuss examples from image processing, non-invasive diagnostics, optogenetics, and phage resistance in bacteria, among others. Lastly, we will briefly discuss quantum networks. The presentation will be specially aimed at undergraduate students.
