6. Transfer of the scholarship for the participant from the partner country and travel expenses takes place after the participant's arrival to Poland within 5 working days to the bank account indicated in the agreement in Euros.
7. The sending University determines the funding rules for travel and stay with the university teacher.
8. The host University may indicate the field of interest to lectures.
9. The host University shall issue on university letterhead *the Letter of Confirmation* to the participant of the program confirming the period of stay at the host university according to the attached pattern.
10. The sending University and the host University take the information and publicity measures among lecturers and students of the University about participation in the program through the internet, emails, meetings and other available means.
11. The St. Xavier's College, Kolkata undertakes to provide The College of Social and Media Culture with information on the implementation of the program Partner Countries required in the final report within the previously fixed deadline.
12. Wyższa Szkoła Kultury Społecznej i Medialnej has the infrastructure to welcome staff with disabilities.


