Since the time of its inception, the College has been recognized by the University Grants Commission under Section 2(f). It is a Grant-in-Aid College and affiliated to the University of Calcutta, Kolkata. Syamaprasad College, named after Dr. Syamaprasad Mukherjee, ex-Vice Chancellor, University of Calcutta, initially started as Asutosh College of Commerce in 1945. In 1958, the college received the status of an independent college under the instruction of the University Grants Commission with the approval and affiliation from University of Calcutta to teach Honours Courses in Accountancy and Secretarial Practice in Commerce and in Bengali and In English in Arts.

Since then Syamaprasad College has steadily developed a lot. To become a Multi-Shift College with several honours courses as well as different Post-Graduate Courses under the affiliation of Burdwan University and Netaji Subhas Open University. In 2013 the college achieved the accreditation from National Assessment And Accreditation Council (NAAC), with a CGPA of 2.37 and a B grade.

The college offer Honours courses in different humanities, Science and Commerce courses. It is the only college under the University of Calcutta offering an Honours in French.
