

## REVISITING EARLY HISTORIC AND EARLY MEDIEVAL INDIA (600 BCE to 1200 CE)

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1. Remembering and understanding the key events in Early Historic and Early Medieval India (600 BCE to 1200 CE) through the analysis of epigraphic and literary sources.
2. Analyzing the different issues in Early Historic and Early Medieval Indian history such as changing polities, the debate about 'Feudalism' in India, Varna-Jati relations, gender relations, urbanity and urban culture.
3. Evaluating the complexity of Varna-Jati relations in India during this time period and understanding its impact on society.
4. Applying critical thinking skills to assess the gender relations and roles of women in Early Historic and Early Medieval India.
5. Synthesizing information on urban culture and its development in Early Historic and Early Medieval India.
6. Reflecting on the religious traditions prevalent in Early Historic and Early Medieval India and their influence on society.
7. Comparing and contrasting Indian art, architecture, and painting styles from the Early Historic and Early Medieval periods to understand the evolution of aesthetics in the region.

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
