# **Rules and Regulations for International Studies Programme**

(All Rules are subject to change)

#### **Admission of International students**

Foreign nationals and NRI students can apply under the category of International students. A detail of the admission procedures of international students is available on the College Website.

Students have to apply through the Study in India programme, a flagship project under the Ministry of HRD, the Govt. of India. St. Xavier's College is also offering fee waivers for 23 seats under this programme.

# Fees for Foreign Nationals

- Candidates from developed countries shall pay double the standard fees.
- Candidates from all other countries shall pay fees at par with Indian students
- OCI/PIO candidates who obtained their cards before 04.03.2021 shall have the
  option to apply for admission either as foreign nationals or at par with Indian
  nationals under the unreserved (general/open) category, subject to the fee
  structure applicable to Indian students.
- They shall not be entitled to reservation benefits under categories such as EWS, OBC-NCL, SC, or ST.

# SEMESTER EXCHANGE PROGRAMME ELIGIBILITY AND CREDIT TRANSFER POLICY

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- Second year Students, having no arrears and maintaining minimum 75% attendance till date may apply.
- English language proficiency required for semester long exchange programmes (any one of the following):

IELTS Academic Version	6.5 with no individual band below 6
Cambridge Proficiency in English (CPE)	Grade C

Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE)	Grade A
Pearson Test of English (Academic)	PTE Academic: a minimum score of 63 (with no section score below 59)
TOEFL	Paper based 570 with a TWE (test of written English) score of 4.5  Computer based 233 with a score of 4.5 in the essay
	Internet based 90 with a written score of 21

## **COURSE APPROVAL**

It is strongly recommended that a student should obtain approval from the DEAN/HOD for at least twice as many papers as they intend to take in order to have backup options pre-approved prior to the exchange. (A pool of options).

**Note:** Students should be allowed to choose from the broader prospective of the discipline and not by exact matching of the exchange semester papers.

#### **CREDIT TRANSFER**

CREDITS WITH FIXED TRANSFER RATES: 15 US Credits = 22 SXC Credits 30 ECTS = 22 SXC Credits

## **OTHER CREDIT TYPES**

To calculate credit value for credits that do not have a fixed transfer rate is either to provide the Host Institution Equivalence Policy with respect to ECTS or to measure how long students are in the classroom, i.e.15 contact hours = 1 SXC credit.

#### **DISCLAIMER**

In case the students fail to successfully obtain the required number of equivalent Host institution credits or there is a discontinuance of the exchange programme, they **have to** complete the credit requirement at the home institution subsequently.
