

LINKAGE AGREEMENT
Between
St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Kolkata, India
And
Sanjay Saraf Educational Institute

St. Xavier's College (Autonomous) – Raghobpur Campus, Kolkata (hereinafter SXC), located at Nepalgange PO, Kolkata, Magurkhali West Bengal 700103, India, and, Sanjay Saraf Educational Institute, (hereinafter SSEI), registered under Exlytics Pvt. Ltd. located at 6A, Elgin Road, Kolkata, agree to cooperate in regard to programs based on the principle of reciprocity. SXC and SSEI are referred to individually as a “party” and collectively as “parties”.

This Linkage Agreement serves as a framework document for both parties to establish and develop a mutual framework for planning, collaboration, and working in partnership towards meeting the shared goal of strengthening the educational skills of the students of SXC.

The parties hereby agree as follows:

- A. Both parties will work together to develop mutual agreements for cooperation based on educational needs of the students of SXC. The activities in which specific agreements may be developed include:
 1. Assistance to students for study, research, internships, workshop and project;
 2. Coordination of such activities as joint research, lectures, conferences, seminars and on-job training;
- B. Responsibility
Both parties should establish meetings / communication to organize programs / activities.
Both parties should collaboratively schedule goal specific programs / activities.
Both parties should designate dedicated coordinators for this purpose.
SSEI shall share activity / progress report with SXC from time to time
SSEI shall provide completion report and issue certificate of completion to the benefactors of the agreement.
- C. Friendly negotiations: Should there arise any other issues not provided for, both parties shall address such issues through friendly negotiations.
- D. Both parties shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this agreement. Neither party shall make a claim against the other party for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon between the parties.
- E. Confidentiality:
 1. Both parties will maintain the confidentiality of all Confidential Information of the disclosing party and will not disclose any Confidential Information to any employees or to any third party except on a need to know basis. Such confidentiality obligations are subject to applicable law and shall survive and continue beyond the expiration or termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.
 2. “Confidential Information” means in respect of a party, all of that party’s Intellectual Property and information relating to that party’s private or business affairs, including, without limitation, technical, financial, operational, administrative, marketing, economic and other information, which is disclosed by one party to the other party, its officers,



employees, agents or sub-contractors.

F.

1. Governing Law Clause: Both parties acknowledge that execution of this Linkage Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state.
2. This Linkage Agreement reflects the respective institutions commitments to both educational and academic exchanges as of the date of the Linkage Agreement.
3. This Linkage Agreement shall become effective on the first day after both parties have signed the document, and shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years from that date. It will be automatically renewed for further periods of equal time, if it is not rescinded by either party. Any necessary modifications or early termination of this Linkage Agreement require written notice of six months in advance. In case this Linkage Agreement ceases to be effective on account of termination, the provisions of all valid supplemental agreements shall continue to apply to the extent necessary to secure the implementation of existing activities as agreed upon in the supplemental agreements.
4. This Linkage Agreement is executed in English in two copies, one for each party, which have equal legal effects.

G. Financial Arrangements

Details regarding commercial terms, revenue sharing, or per-student charges shall be mutually decided and annexed separately as an Annexure-A to this MoU and may be updated periodically with written consent from both parties.

Annexure A:

A. Roles, responsibilities and obligations of SSEI:

1. SSEI will deliver the program
 - CoreFMV: Financial Modelling and Valuation Certification Program
 - The program duration is 100+ hours.
 - The program comprises of: live+recorded lectures; real-world case studies; comprehensive learning materials; practical assignments; career enhancement tools.
2. The program duration is 6 months.
3. Total fees for the program is INR 15000 per student. SXC will get INR 3000 per student out of the mentioned fees here.
4. Schedule: 3 Classes per week (Live + Recorded) with periodic face-to-face doubt-solving sessions.

B. Roles, responsibilities and obligations of SXC:

1. SXC shall promote the program among it's students and shall be responsible for enrollments.
2. SXC shall comply with all norms prescribed by regulatory authorities including UGC, AICTE, and other applicable bodies, and shall keep SSEI informed of any policies that may impact the execution of this partnership.
3. SXC shall coordinate with SSEI to ensure that no disruption occurs in student learning and that relevant communication material and student engagement tools are provided in a timely manner.
4. SXC, Raghapur Campus shall make available at least one classroom with a capacity of up to 60 students for conducting physical classes/ doubt-solving sessions scheduled by SSEI.
