

Conference Report- Niti Dialogue'23

Niti Dialogue 2023- First of its kind International Interdisciplinary Policy Conference with special focus on public policy was held at St. Xavier's College(Autonomous), Kolkata on Saturday, 11th March 2023 on Zoom Platform.

This International Conference hosted 6 distinguished speakers from 4 different countries and envisioned to impart students with a broader understanding of policy, policy-making, and implementation.

Rev. Dr. Dominic Savio, SJ - Principal, St. Xavier's College(Autonomous), Kolkata was the Chief Patron of this International Conference. Prof. Dr. Chandrani Biswas, HOD BA General and Communicative English and Prof. Dr. Jhumpa Mukherjee, HOD Political Science were the Professors-In-Charge. Nakshatra Jagannath of BA General and Soumyajit Paul of department of Economics led the student board comprising students from BA General, Department of Economics, and Department of Commerce namely: Khushi Mishra, Jassi Agarwal, Kushagra Kapoor, Arsh Marwah, Khushi Agarwal, Harsh Harlalka, and Somya Jalan for this event.

Nakshatra Jagannath, and Soumyajit Paul displayed immense leadership qualities as Student Directors, and Convenors for the International Conference under the guidance of Prof. Dr. Chandrani Biswas, and Prof. Dr. Jhumpa Mukherjee.

The Conference commenced with an introduction by Prof. Dr. Chandrani Biswas, HOD, BA General, and Communicative English followed by an inaugural address by Rev. Dr. Dominic Savio, S.J, Principal, St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Kolkata followed by 6 speaker sessions of 15 minutes each, also encompassing a Q&A round. The conference was also live streamed on YouTube with over 150 live attendees from across various departments of St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Kolkata The resource persons for this International Policy Conference were:

1. Prof. Viney Pal Aneja (USA)

- Scientist, and Former Co-Director of graduate programs at Dept. of Marine, Earth, and Atmospheric Sciences, North Carolina State University, USA.

- Prof. Aneja has also served as Scientific Counselor to the US Government and allied bodies on matters concerning the Environment.

- He has been recognized by Stanford University as the top 2 percent Scientists in the world and has authored 195 scientific papers, 130 book chapters, 47 technical reports, 5 US patents, and has been invited as resource person to over 525 conferences.

- Prof. Aneja spoke on the urgent need for proactive measures in the policy-making spectrum to safeguard the environment. He also shed light on the deteriorating condition of the environment, on agricultural emissions in the USA. He also spoke on the imperative issue of Global Warming and principal mitigation efforts taken in the USA in the agricultural and allied sector to safeguard the environment in a natural way. Dr. Aneja also shed light on policy status on the environment in USA, and Europe. He concluded highlighting the vital need for enhanced legal, and statuary frameworks, and effective leadership in the public policy sector.

2. Prof. Ramamurthy Rallabandi (India)

- Former HOD, Dept. of Aero, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University.

- Prof. Rallabandi spoke on the role of policy-making, and implementation in the science and technology sector. He also shed light on the imperative need for different sectors to cooperate. Prof. Rallabandi also shared his personal experiences on working with top Indian scientific agencies, and his interaction with stalwarts of the scientific world like Dr. Shivathanu Pillai, CEO of BrahMos and with Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, Former President of India.

3. CA CS Puja Anand (Australia)

- Former Deputy Chief Financial Officer, IBA, Government of Australia.

- Member of ICAI, ICSI, and CAANZ. An Alumna of Lady Shri Ram College, University of Delhi.

- CA CS Puja Anand spoke about corporate policy-making, and the relation between the corporate sector, policy-making, and public policy. She shed light on her experience working as the Dy. Chief Financial Officer with IBA, Government of Australia, which seeks to assist and enhance the economic development of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people across Australia. She also shed light on other public policy measures taken in Australia, and myriad career opportunities available in the sector.

4. Mr. Amit Chadha (Canada)

- Director, Agile Lead, Financial Sector. Currently working with one of North America's biggest financial institution.

- Mr. Chadha spoke on the relation between the financial sector and public policy. He also cited publicly available examples of the financial sector across the globe charting out effective policies for the public and taking efficient measures during the the Covid-19 pandemic, with special focus on students, working class, and the elderly.

5. Dr. Vishal Chadha (India)

- Senior Government Doctor, NCT of Delhi.

- Joint General Secretary, Dadhichi Deh Daan Samiti- A nationally renowned organ donation NGO that conducted the Swasth Sabal Bharat Conclave in 2022 inaugurated by the Hon. Union Health Minister, and graced by the Hon. Vice President of India among other distinguished dignitaries. Dr. Chadha is also a regular invitee to Sansad TV- India's Parliamentary Channel to speak on Healthcare, and Organ Donation.

- Dr. Chadha spoke on healthcare sector, public policy, and organ donation, and efforts of Dadhichi Deh Daan Samiti in the social sector and suggestions made by the organization to the Indian Government. He cited examples from the past of effective legislations enacted by the Parliament that have aided healthcare and the cause of organ donation in India. He also spoke on urgent need of policy revamp and role of surveys. He also shed light on various measures taken in the medical and organ donation spectrum in the recent past.

6. Mr. Dighbijoy Samaddar (India)
