

The Crest of St. Xavier's College is modeled on Jassu Crest of the College Patron Saint Francis Xavier's family. It has been adapted to local surroundings, suggestive of a native flavour of a College in India.

The escutcheon in white and blue contains a tiger and a palm tree, overlooked by a silver crescent moon, which symbolizes the palacio of Xavier. The charge on the Dexter, HIS, bespeaks a College of the Society of Jesus (Iesus Hominum Salvator - Jesus, Savior of Human Family). The checky argent and sable in the base recall the spirit of the Xaverian family.

A garter bearing the words "St. Xavier's College, Calcutta", encircles the escutcheon and it is surmounted by a Cross emanating holy rays. A scroll passes underneath inscribed with the words "Nihil Ultra," (Nothing Beyond"), the motto of the College.

The Crest signifies dignity, courage, quiet gleam and the call of the beyond - the quest persists towards higher endeavour.

Message from Rev. Dr. Dominic Savio, SJ Principal

t. Xavier's College is a hundred and sixty-three years and counting. We have a history and a heritage which we endeavour to preserve but that history and heritage is also an inspiration and guide that compels us to build on the past and take this college in to new territories and directions that our illustrious forbears would approve, laud and validate. It has been the endeavour of successive principals including the present to realise and make real the fundamental vision of Nihil Ultra. This is not simply Nothing beyond. Rather it means and signifies to us the fact that nothing is beyond our imagination or grasp or achievement. This vision of limitless possibilities began to fructify in 2006 when the college was granted autonomy. But the recognition that we were worthy of being so granted the privilege of autonomy came with an acknowledged responsibility. And that responsibility is what we have shouldered and continue to shoulder into the present. That we have borne our responsibilities reasonably well is I think evidenced by the constant curve of upward growth that we have been able to maintain over the 15 years of our autonomy.

Beginning with the award of College with Potential for Excellence, we have been honoured with numerous acknowledgements of our academic endeavours and achievements. These include being conferred the status of College of Excellence in 2014, and College with a special Heritage status in 2015.

Beginning in 2003, we have been through 3 cycles of NAAC assessment. From an A grade in the first assessment, we have improved our rating to an A++ grade in the last assessment which was conducted in 2017.

Our NIRF ratings have further validated our attempts to maintain the highest possible academic values and standards. After the first NIRF audit in 2017, our ranking has steadily climbed to 5th position out of 1802 participating colleges in 2023. We happily take this as a just measure of our constant efforts to improve the quality of the education we impart to our students. To help and guide us on our continuing path of quality expansion, we regularly undertake academic audits.

To keep a vigilant eye on the quality of our academic standards from independent auditors who can assess and suggest areas of further improvement, we have enlisted for ISO 9001: 2015 certification which, after a rigorous scrutiny of our academic, examination and administrative systems, was granted in 2019 and is continuing to the present after 2 surveillance audits which were recently concluded for the



vears 2020 and 2021.

Initiated in 2015, the Ph.D. program is now offered by 4 Science departments, Commerce Department and 3 Arts Departments. Currently there are 43 research guides and 97 scholars. Transforming the departments into Research departments is the inevitable and natural culmination of academic expansion. It is my personal dream to ensure that all the undergraduate departments become post-graduate departments by 2025 and 2 years later be readied to offer doctoral degrees.

To accommodate this ambitious expansion we have begun the process of building the second campus on the E.M. Bypass. Initially envisaged as a Media Hub for the Mass Com and Multimedia departments, we have redesigned our plans and decided to set up research-based science departments at this campus. Generous space will ne allotted for state-of-the-art labs, facilities and research centres.

Since we envision St Xavier's to be a research-oriented institution offering a seamless progression from undergrad to doctoral studies, we have begun to lay greater and greater emphasis on research. Significant and increasing volume of research is being undertaken by many science departments as witnessed by the increasing amounts of research project grants the college has obtained, rising from 4,30,31486.00 in 2018 to 28.30.61011.00 in 2020-21.

In the midst the drive to expand and proliferate, we remain a college with a conscience whose mission is to reach the benefits of quality education to the underprivileged, the marginalised and to students from the rural hinterland. I am happy and proud to announce that our Ragabhpur campus has successfully bridged the rural-urban divide and has brought about significant changes in the rural areas it serves. The campus has been undergoing extensive expansion and upgradation, has opened postgraduate departments, and is looking to offer vocational courses designed to meet and fulfil the needs of the local populace. The Ragabhpur campus is one of our most significant achievements educationally as well as socially.

Jesuit Education aims to produce men and women for others, men and women who will have an integrated and a holistic approach to life. In the context of India's multi-religious and multi-cultural realities, we need leaders in every field who promote inter-religious and social harmony.

The Foundation Course at St. Xavier's College aims to give every Xaverian an opportunity to develop acceptance and appreciation of multi-religious, multi-cultural and multi-linguistic context of India and to appreciate every religion and to be rooted in one's own religion.

Best Practices

- Selection and storage of the abstracts of best dissertations/ student research projects of each department in electronic repositories on the website, and in a special dissertation section in the library. Publication of a book with ISBN Number containing edited form of these dissertations.
- 2. Inter-disciplinary Academic Research.
- 3. Involvement of Ph.D. students in the theory, computation and lab classes of departments. This will enable them to obtain some useful teaching experiences.
- 4. Offering a 12–16-day online summer recess course on topics not covered by the syllabus.
- 5. THREE MINUTE THESIS: An annual competition for PhD and PG students to present their research in just 3 minutes so as to be understood by an audience with no background in the research area. The exercise will require participants to effectively present and explain their work with clarity and lucidity. Participants will also have to explain why their work matters, and prove its relevance and value.
- Contemporary and Industry Ready Curriculum and Syllabus: The curriculum and syllabi are revised and updated every three years in consultation with eminent academics, industry experts and key stakeholders. Innovative new courses like Business Data Analytics have been incorporated.
- 7. Exposure to Industry through Industry Visits and Internship.
- 8. Extensive use of Finance Lab (installed with Bloomberg software) by organizing workshops on impact of latest trends in technologies on the society/research along with the topics like Fintech, Blockchain & Crypto-Currency, HR/Marketing/Finance Analytics.
- 9. Instituting the "Poverty Lab" in the college to conduct research studies, workshops, awareness programmes for promoting financial literacy and other social development projects.
- 10. Organizing Exhibition cum Fair in the College for those students who have their own businesses and start ups. They will be able to showcase their product/idea in this manner.
- 11. Hand-holding guidance to students' Start-Ups to obtain IPRs such as Patent, Trade-Mark registration, Copyright of fresh literary or art work. Guidance to SXC Facultiy to obtain IPRs such as Patent, Copyright of fresh literary or art work, publications, etc.
- 12. A recognition/reward system for students which identifies "The most interactive student" / "The most active student" for every classroom. At the end of the semester a Certificate may be provided to them from the department.
- 13. Adoption of centres taking care of differently abled females.
- 14. Involvement of students in Consultancy projects.
- 15. Vidyadeepam Project: 1st & 2nd year B.Ed. students visit 2 Government Schools for the marginalised section in Raghabpur every week.

 They help both primary & secondary students with their Education, Co-Curricular Activities, Spoken English, Art & Craft & Skills Development.
- 16. Videos & online resources are prepared for various national & international events, in order to spread social awareness on important issues—International Women's Day, World Cancer Day, World Education Day and World Environment Day.
- 17. Organization of Capacity Building Programmes for in-service teachers.
- 18. Organization of development programmes for support staff.
- 19. Skill Development through Skill Hub.
- 20. Contemporary Research through Gender Study Centre.
- 21. Regular mentoring of students by professors.
